Whitepaper for the preparation of a product data feed

1. Provision of data process

To enable your products to be represented on our portal, we require as much up-to-date information about your articles as possible. Some information is essential (mandatory fields), while some supports you in presenting your products in a detailed and informative way (recommended and optional fields).

Your product data feed will be regularly checked for updates. This white paper provides information on all the requirements for a product data feed.

IMPORTANT: The quality of your product data feed has an influence on the results and the profitability of the product listing. The higher the quality of the product data, the better the quality of the generated traffic.

2. Product data feed

2.1 General information on the structure of the product data feed

- Each field name may only be assigned once.
- Some fields feature the additional text “**Multiple entries possible**”. This means that several values can be defined for this field. It is thus possible, e.g., to transfer several product images for a product.

This can be carried out in two ways:

1. You can extend the field names with the suffix “List” (e.g. imageUri becomes imageUriList).

This addition means that the values in this field are a list.

You can now enter several values into a field. These values must be separated by a separator (“,” “;” “|” are permitted). Make sure that you do not use the same separator that you used for the CSV.

2. Number the fields using a suffix (e.g. imageUri becomes imageUri1, imageUri2, etc.)

This means that the field occurs multiple times.

You can now enter the values into the fields.

- In both cases, please take care with the sorting. This is particularly important for images. Thus, the field with the “1” at the end or the first image in the list later becomes the main image.
- If you are unable to create a feed specifically according to our wishes, we will be happy to check whether we can import an existing feed (e.g. GoogleShopping PLA).
- Please note that the more information on your products you provide us with, the better we are able to control your products. This has also a direct influence on the level of performance.
- If you would like to transfer information to us that does not fit in the fields listed below, this is not a problem. Simply add them to other columns. We will then automatically check whether we can import the transferred information.

2.2 File contents - mandatory fields

It is essential that the following fields exist and are filled in.
